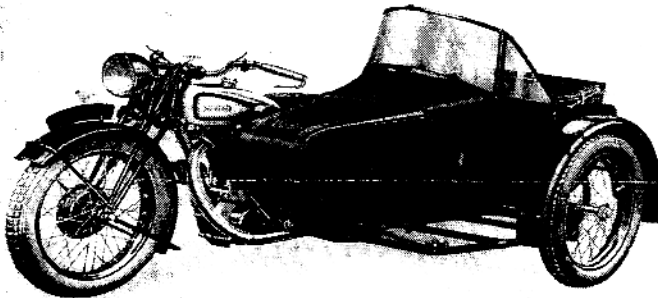

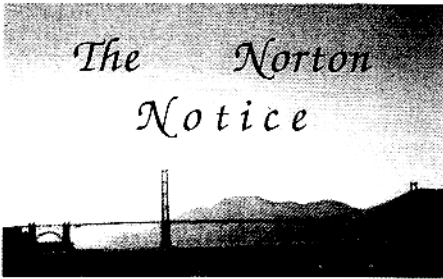

It's that time of year again. Time for the British motorcycle ride in the Bay Area. If you only go to one ride a year, this is the one! This ride brings out an eclectic mix of some of the best looking bikes, some of least seen Marks and a few of the most interesting rolling wrecks you will ever see all in one place.

Sponsored by the BSA Owners Club of Northern California, **the ride departs promptly at 10:00AM from the Lot 36 Restaurant (formerly Lyons) at 940 7<sup>th</sup> Street, in Novato.** The ride will be approximately 3 hours long and will wind through some of the most beautiful Bay Area scenery there is on some of the best motorcycle roads anywhere. 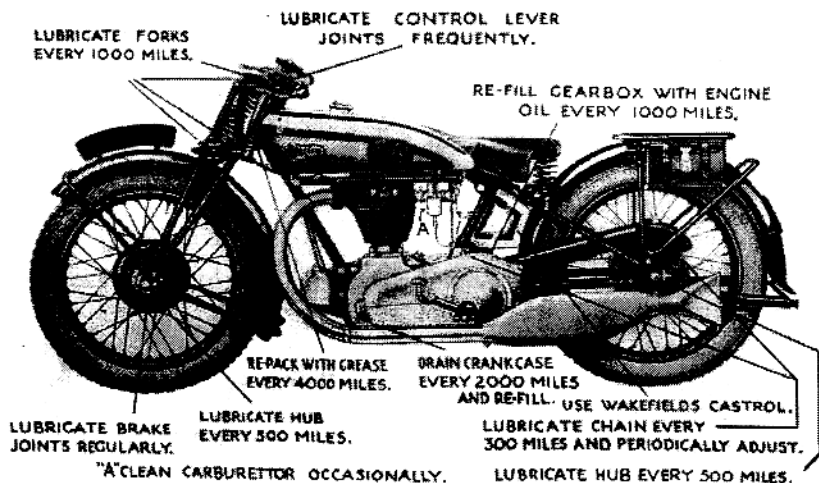

## Mt. Hamilton Ride

Downtown Pleasanton was all blocked off for some kind of street fair, so it took us around a half hour to find the back alley behind Deans. We just about had time to get helmets off for a bit, then Greg Fuller led us out the back way, through the southern outskirts of Livermore, and through the hills on Corral Hollow. Just before reaching 580, Bruce McGregor pulled over with what turned out to be a broken coil wire. About six of us stayed with Bruce for a road-side tech session, while the rest went on down Rt 33. After about half hour, Bruce found the broken wire himself, and we were quickly under way again.

To make up lost time, our ride went straight down I5 to Patterson. All the bikes did great at 75 mph, and once on Del Puerto Canyon, we evened out the tire wear by not going straight at all, for 20 miles. It was a fast and fabulous ride, despite the heat of the day. Fourteen riders, eleven on Nortons, made it to the Junction lunch stop. After lunch some of us went up to Mt. Hamilton, where it was at least 10 degrees cooler. It's great to watch old bikes carve through the 300+ turns on the road down from the summit, with it's birds-eye view of the endless switchbacks.

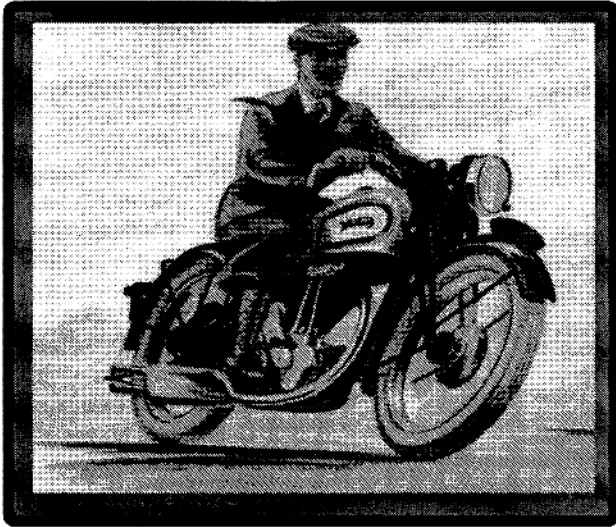
